



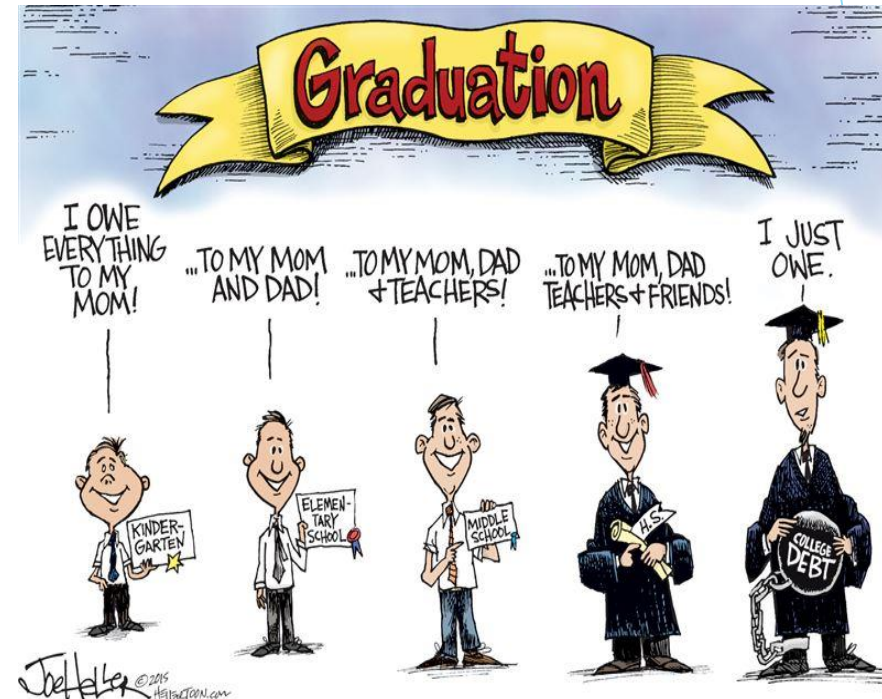

- ▶ STEP 1: APPLY ONLINE
  - [ccbcmd.edu/apply](http://ccbcmd.edu/apply)
- ▶ STEP 2: VISIT ADMISSIONS OFFICE
  - Bring Photo ID
  - Bring SAT (480 Evidence Based Reading & Writing & 530 Math) or ACT (21+) scores
  - Access your BCPSONE for GPA verification
  - Submit Early College Access Consent Form
- ▶ STEP 3: TAKE ACCUPLACER PLACEMENT TEST If Needed
  - [ccbcmd.edu/practicetest](http://ccbcmd.edu/practicetest)
- ▶ STEP 4: MEET WITH AN ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT
  - Discuss Placement Testing Scores
  - Discuss Re-Testing if needed
  - Register for Classes
- ▶ STEP 5: FOLLOW-UP WITH ADMISSIONS COUNSELOR
  - Discuss Tuition Waiver Eligibility
  - Final Billing

# CAREER AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION PATHWAY PROGRAMS

- Earn free college credits upon completion of Career and Technology Education (CTE) Pathway
- To receive free articulated credits with CCBC, students must:
  - Complete a minimum of 4 high school credits in the Career Pathway/Completer
  - Some pathways may require a portfolio review

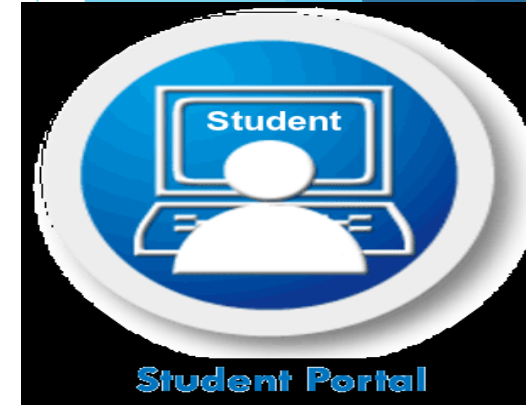



  - COURSES WILL BE COUNTED TOWARD COURSE QUOTA IF DROPPED AFTER CLASS START DATE
- ▶ PARALLEL ENROLLMENT PROGRAM STUDENTS
  - STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR PAYING 50% OF THE BILL IF COURSE IS DROPPED AFTER CLASS START DATE
- ▶ ALL EARLY COLLEGE ACCESS PROGRAM STUDENTS
  - CANCELLED COURSES RESULT IN 100% REFUND OF TUITION AND APPLICABLE FEES
  - CONTACT THE EARLY COLLEGE ACCESS COORDINATOR IF YOU ADD/DROP A COURSE
- ▶ WITHDRAWAL FROM COURSE
  - APPEAL FOR A TUITION REFUND IF WITHDRAWING FROM A COURSE DUE TO EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES
