


 - Bring Photo ID
 - Bring SAT (480 Evidence Based ACT (21+) scores
 - Access your BCPSONE for GPA verification
 - Submit Early College Access **Consent Form**
 - STEP 3: TAKE ACCUPLACER PLACEMENT **TEST If Needed**
 - ccbcmd.edu/practicetest

- STEP 4: MEET WITH AN ACADEMIC **ADVISEMENT**
 - Discuss Placement Testing Scores
 - Discuss Re-Testing if needed
 - Register for Classes

 - Discuss Tuition Waiver Eligibility
 - Final Billing




